Arriving in Austria in 1989 Wolfgang (Bill) Price served as diplomat for the U.S. Government at the International Atomic Energy Agency (I.A.E.A.) engaged in preparing protocols for extension of the NPT and coordinating R&D development. Remaining in Austria he has worked as a private economic consultant for UNIDO and USAID, on industry and state government industrial development projects in Austria, Poland, Lithuania, and Kazakhstan. In Ukraine (2000-2003) he was engaged in restoring the nation's economic base implementing concepts for industrial clusters in revitalizing productive sectors. In Thailand (2009) he provided technical assistance in improving conditions at border refugee camps. In Austria he consulted on privatizing the Schoeller-Bleckmann industrial complex in Ternitz.
