

Brief bio

Ana Revenco has been appointed as *director of Centre for Strategic Communication and Countering Disinformation* in October 2023.

By then, Ms. Revenco served for two years as Minister of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Moldova. Among the key achievements: negotiating Frontex mission in Moldova, negotiating the launch of the European Union Partnership Mission in Moldova, negotiating the association of the Republic of Moldova to the European Civil Protection Mechanism, initiating the EU Support Hub for Internal Security and Border Management, which has placed the fight against hybrid warfare on the internal affairs agenda.

While acting as National Defense and Security Adviser to President of the Republic of Moldova Maia Sandu, she was appointed as Secretary of the Supreme Security Council between January and August 2021.

As international trainer on fighting human trafficking and related crimes, Ms. Revenco delivered expertise as member of GRETA Group of Experts of the Council Europe for two years by January 2021.

She founded the International Center La Strada Moldova (NGO) in August 2001 focusing on protection of human rights, and held office as its Executive Director by August 2012, and afterwards between September 2015 and December 2020.

In between September 2012 and March 2015, Ms. Revenco headed the Center for Combating Trafficking in Persons of the General Police Inspectorate (GPI) under the Moldovan Ministry of Internal Affairs. Meanwhile she was responsible for coordinating the GPI efforts on implementation of the EU-Moldova Action Plan on Visa Liberalization, representing also the GPI in the related Intergovernmental Working Group.
